Stay & Play will recommence on Monday 13th September. It operates on bubble protocol and takes place outside (weather permitting). Stay & Play is available from 2pm until 4pm. **The cost is £3.50 for one hour or £6.00 for 2 hours on the same day.**

In line with Covid regulations it is essential that you book in advance for the week ahead. Please ensure that all bookings are made on or before Friday of the week prior to when stay & play is required. Unfortunately, we will not be able to accommodate your child if prior booking and payment has not been made. Please book a free PCR test, even if an earlier one was negative. Your child should stay at home and self-isolate until you receive the result. Please see
